



Self-Collection Instructions for Patients to test for sexually transmitted infections

Vaginal swab




• After collection, break the handle by the red mark and insert the swab into the liquid medium ensuring the lid is properly closed.

Anal swab



• After collection, break the handle by the red mark and insert the swab into the liquid medium ensuring the lid is properly closed.

Penile swab




• After collection, break the handle by the red mark and insert the swab into the liquid medium ensuring the lid is properly closed.


Post collection

1. Ensure that the specimens are labelled with your full name and DOB
2. Place the swab / urine container inside the specimen bag
3. Hand the self-collected swab / urine container to our collection staff

Throat swab
