

# 4Cyte Pathology Warfarin Management Program

Clinicians can now enrol their patients ONLINE through our website at www.4cyte.com.au/clinicians/warfarin-care-program.

We have also introduced an SMS service to patients or their nominated carers with their warfarin instructions (including INR result, dose and date of next visit).



## Simply follow these steps:



## STEP 1:

Fill out the online Enrolment Form.



#### STEP 2:

Upon submission of this Registration form we will automatically send a link via SMS to the Patient's or their nominated Carer's mobile to complete their Patient Registration Form.



## STEP 3:

Send through a Request Form marked 'INR – 4Cyte Lab To Control' - Rule 3 exemption; and request one-off FBC & E/LFT's if no test with 4Cyte Pathology in the previous 2 months.



## **STEP 4:**

Once patients have had their INR blood collected, we will send the patient or their nominated Carer their results via SMS only within 24-36 hours.

We recommend that the patient continue taking their usual dose of warfarin until they receive their newest results.

Both the Warfarin Care Enrolment Form and the Patient Registration Form must be fully completed before patients are accepted into our Warfarin Care Management Program.

The dedicated 'Warfarin Management Program' link can also be used for registering Nursing Home patients, submission of Hospital Discharge form and Ceasing Warfarin form.
